

#### From the Vicar, the Revd Rosy Barrie

"the lot fell on Matthias" (Acts 1:15-end) St Matthias is remembered in the church on May 14<sup>th</sup>

The Acts of the Apostles, a book of the New Testament we read during Eastertide, are full of fascinating information about the beginnings of the church, including an election. It was felt essential to have a replacement for Judas. Two men are proposed, with equal qualifications, they had been with the other 11 apostles during Jesus' ministry and were also witnesses to his resurrection. The apostles then pray that God will chose the right person: casting lots is a way of saying this decision was in God's hands. Matthias is chosen as the new number 12 apostle.

This is an election year, not just for our city as we vote for a new mayor, not just for our country, as at some point a general election will be called, but for a huge proportion of the population of the world. Not all of these elections will be fair or truly representative, and many of us will admire the courage and integrity of protesters who therefore refuse to vote or deliberately spoil their ballot paper. But what about those of us who are entitled to vote, what are we going to do when the time comes? There are moments when we are highly critical of local or national politicians, when we feel it's not worth voting for any of them. Yet surely if we don't bother to vote we run the risk of giving more power to the extremist ends of the political spectrum who can motivate their supporters to turn out. This could tip the country's balance into an direction we don't really want it to go. Choosing by lot isn't an option, but praying before hand really is. May we treasure our democratic right to vote by using it in a wise and godly way, with the hope that God will work in politics as well as in our own lives, for the common good of us all.

#### APRIL

Fit more active travel into your day and daily routine. Reevaluate your journeys: explore walking or cycling options, or modify your route to include some form of active travel, i.e. disembark a stop early and complete the remaining part of your journey on foot, indulge in a leisurely stroll, or opt for a bike ride along a cyclist-friendly route. Consider connecting with your local Ramblers or cycling group for shared experiences. Use the extra steps or the changed travel arrangements as a prompt to pray for God's creation, nature's preservation and the reduction in fossil fuel usage.

#### MAY

Say no to the mow. Mowing your lawn less and letting parts grow long saves you time and helps give nature a home. If you want to make an even bigger impact on wildlife, wait to mow your lawn or a section of it until August to support even more animals. Contribute to citizen science and get to know what (and who!) lives in your church's green space - sign up to take part in Churches Count on Nature (8-16 June 2024) at caringforgodsacre.org.uk/churches- count-on-nature-faqs/.

*PS.* We are definitely up to be part of churches count on nature this year again.






